

Maryland Environmental Disclosure Statement Atlantic Energy MD, LLC January 1, 2025 – June 1, 2025

This disclosure is required under Maryland Public Service Commission Order No 77666, 76241, 77412 and Case No 8738.

Power plants can generate electricity from a number of different fuel sources, resulting in different emissions that impact the environment. Atlantic Energy MD, LLC will report fuel sources and emissions to customers twice a year, allowing you to compare this electricity product with electricity products offered by other electricity suppliers.

Atlantic Energy MD, LLC is a member of the PJM regional transmission organization that coordinates the movement of wholesale electricity in all or parts of 13 states and the District of Columbia.
